NOTIFICATION Submission of Text Books for Class XII Semester IV

As directed, this is to notify that the Publishers intending to avail T.B No(s) for their Text Books on elective subjects for Class XII [semester IV] are hereby informed about the following points:-

- 1. Text Books on elective subjects [other than vocational subjects] will be accepted for allotment of TB Nos.
- 2. The Council would start accepting books from 23rd June, 2025. The sooner the book is submitted, the earlier would start the process of Book Review and TB No. allotment on our part.
- 3. Copies of books to be submitted at the Academic Section 02 copies of each book. 01 copy is to be submitted without any mention of author or publisher. Please note that, books or the fee submitted won't be returned by Council for the disqualified books.
- 4. Fee to be deposited at the time of submission of books Rs.8.000/- (Rupees Eight Thousand only) per book for books on a certain semester of Class XI or Class XII. Fee is to be submitted through Bank Draft/ Bankers cheques drawn in favour of "West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education" payable at Kolkata.
- 5. Books are to be in 4-colour and size of the book must be 22" X 32". The page limit specified for that subject should be strictly followed. Maximum number of lines per page should be 44. Please note that, in case of page limit and book size, the tolerance level on our part will be zero. All the pages (containing subject matter) in the book must be numbered and there should not be any extra pages (with roman numbers or without any number) in the book. Page numbering should not be chapter or unit-wise.
- 6. There is no Chapter wise page limit. However, the chapters should be as per the demand of the topic and should not be unnecessarily lengthened and the book submitted should have a proportionate and even presentation of all the topics in the syllabus for that particular subject. The book contents should be restricted within H.S curriculum and the book price should be kept reasonable.
- Quality of paper to be used:
 190 gsm [Board] for Cover pages and 60 gsm [Maplitho] for other pages.
 Books should be printed with clear legible fonts so that readers would not face any discomfort in reading.
- 8. Question Pattern as published by the Council should be mentioned in the book and at least 2(two) Model Question papers based on the given Question Pattern should be given in the book. No specimen project should be given in the book.

- 9. The Council discourages use of photographs of any current or historical personalities and use of unnecessary photographs, references and footnotes in the book.
- 10. The Publishers should refrain themselves from any sort of marketing or canvassing before getting the T.B No. From the Council.
- 11. Cover of the book does not come under Council Review. So, any picture or text used on the front or back cover of the books, which may arise unnecessary controversies, will be sole responsibility of the publisher.
- 12. Documents to be submitted at the time of submission:
 - a) Separate Filled-in "Book Submission Form" [available under Download Section of Council website] for each book
 - b) Current Trade Licence Certificate
 - c) Current GST certificate, Income Tax Return certificate.
 - d) Payment receipt
- 13. Decision of the Council regarding approval of the book(s) and awarding of T.B No. in favour of the book(s) will be final and binding on the publishers.
- 14. All communication with Council must be done from publisher's end only. The author of any book should not contact any staff or officer of the Council. He/She may communicate with the Hon'ble President of Council through the publisher in writing. In case of violation, the book concerned will be disqualified at that instant.
- 15. 15 copies of each book are to be submitted after getting T.B. No. from the Council and before marketing for the same. There should not be any deviation (in any form) in the copy being marketed from the marketing copy submitted at the Council. No extra booklet should be supplied to the students along with the book. In case, the publisher violates any of the conditions mentioned in the "Declaration from Publisher" after getting the TB No, that particular TB No will be immediately cancelled.
- 16. The publishers are being requested not to make any changes in the contents or setup of the books in which the Council have already allotted TB No. In case, the publishers wants to make any betterment in the book, the book has to be submitted to the Council and the book would be treated as a new submission in all respects.
