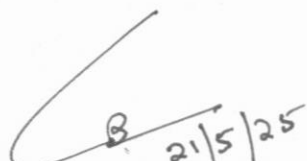
Attention: All Head of Institutions, students and other concerned

In continuation to the Council's Notifications vide No. L/PR/200/2024 dated 13.05.2024 and No. L/PR/242/2024 dated 21.06.2024, the undersigned is to inform the concerned stakeholders regarding the following points -

❖ The students who did not pass in Class XI Examination under Old Annual System till Academic Session 2023-2024, but eligible for fresh admission in the Academic Session 2025-2026 as per regulations, should continue their studies of Class XI (i.e. Semester I and Semester II) under the curriculum of Semester System. The existing registrations of those students have already been cancelled from the end of Council.

❖ The students (eligible as per regulation) who already passed Class XI Examination, but did not appeared/ passed H.S. Examination under the Old Annual System till date, if desired, may continue Class XI (i.e. Semester I and Semester II) afresh under the curriculum of Semester System from the Academic Session 2025-2026. This option is available **only for the Academic Session 2025-2026**, keeping in mind the interest of the students so that they can take the benefit of Semester System, if desired. **Please note that this option will not be available from next academic session and this cannot be cited as precedence.**

❖ For all the above cases, the concerned institutions must re-register those students afresh with the Council under the new Semester System by visiting the Council website (https://wbchseapp.wb.gov.in/portal/sec_users/login) through the institution login at **Re-registration Tab** from **02.06.2025 to 30.06.2025** by surrendering the existing registration certificates and/or the admit card as case may be, to their Head of the Institutions for further records. The condition of registration of a student within three years from the year of passing of his/her Madhyamik Pariksha or equivalent examination including the year of examination, will be relaxed based on his/her prayer.
