

**Rules for Post Publication Scrutiny (PPS) / Post Publication Review (PPR) of the answer script(s) of Semester-IV and H.S. Examination under Old System, 2026**

- 1) A candidate appeared in Semester-IV and H.S. Examination under Old System, 2026 may apply for-
  - a) **Normal PPS/PPR** of his/her answer script(s) from **15.05.2026 at 00.01 hours to 28.05.2026 at 23.59 hours** along with the requisite fee.
  - b) **Tatkal PPS/PPR** of his/her answer script(s) from **15.05.2026 at 00.01 hours to 17.05.2026 at 23.59 hours** along with the requisite fee.

For both options (a) and (b), the candidates have to register with the student's portal first by visiting the website: [https://wbchseapp.wb.gov.in/portal/dashboard\\_student](https://wbchseapp.wb.gov.in/portal/dashboard_student)
- 2) While applying for PPS/PPR on the portal, a candidate needs to provide an undertaking by saying that his/her PPS/PPR application will not be processed, if he/she has applied for certified copy of answer script(s) as per RTI Act, 2005 before publication of his/her PPS/PPR result and in such case(s), he/she will be provided the certified copy of the answer script(s) as per the RTI application.
- 3) Application for PPS/PPR of answer scripts through online mode will only be accepted. No other option for submission of application will be entertained.
- 4) Candidates will have to write the **Roll No. and Mark Sheet No. of Semester-IV or H.S. Examination, under old system as the case may be** for submission of online application.
- 5) Application fees for -
  - a) **Normal PPS is Rs. 150/-** per subject and for **Normal PPR is Rs. 200/-** per subject.
  - b) **Tatkal PPS is Rs. 600/-** per subject and for **Tatkal PPR is Rs. 800/-** per subject.
- 6) Application for PPR/PPS shall be restricted to the theoretical paper(s) only provided that the candidate appeared in H.S. Examination, 2026 in the relevant subject(s) without any malpractice or misconduct report by any of the examination personnel.
- 7) Applicants may seek PPS in **all subjects**, but for PPR in maximum **02 subjects**.
- 8) Application for PPR will only be allowed for the subject(s) in which PPS is not sought for.
- 9) A candidate will be able to seek PPR provided he/she has obtained higher grade in any other three subjects than the grade obtained in the subject(s) for which PPR is sought for.
- 10) An incomplete or incorrect application for PPR/PPS shall summarily be rejected by the Council and no enquiry or correspondence shall be entertained in this regard.
- 11) No application for PPR/PPS shall be entertained beyond the specified period mentioned above under any circumstances.
- 12) Institutions/candidates may see the results of PPS/PPR on the Council's Website. The revised mark sheet /certificate (if applicable) has to be collected from the respective Regional Offices of the Council by the concerned institutions/candidates by surrendering the previous mark sheets/certificates. The institutions will have to maintain the records of such revised marks sheets /certificates of their students.
- 13) The result of normal PPS/PPR may be declared within one month from the cutoff date of submission of application. However, the result of Tatkal PPS/PPR will be published within **eight days** from the date of receipt of online application, failing which, the excess amount of fees deposited (= Tatkal Fees - Normal Fees) by the candidate will be refunded in favour of the candidate, if applied for.
- 14) Candidates shall have to accept the result of PPS/PPR, as the case may be.
- 15) Any matter which is not described herein, to be solely decided by the Council and the decision of the Council will be the final.
