

### NOTIFICATION

The Council has introduced several new subjects in the H.S Curriculum in a period of last two years. Given below are the eligibility criteria for the teachers and schools who can apply for introduction of these subjects.

<b>Artificial Intelligence [ARTI] , Data Science [DTSC] , Cyber Security [CBST]</b>	
Allowed for	Students from Set I
Eligibility Criteria for Schools	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Computer Science [COMS] must be running at the school.</li><li>• Duly qualified teacher in COMS can teach these subjects.</li></ul>
<b>Applied Artificial Intelligence [ APAI ]</b>	
Allowed for	Students from Set II & III
Eligibility Criteria for Schools	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Computer Science [COMS] or Modern Computer Application [COMA] must be running at the school.</li><li>• Duly qualified teacher in COMS or COMA can teach this subject.</li></ul>
<i><b>It may be noted that one duly qualified teacher can teach at most three subjects out of COMA , COMS , ARTI , DTSC , CBST and APAI. Any school having more than three of these subjects should have two duly qualified teachers.</b></i>	
<b>Science of Wellbeing [SOWB]</b>	
Allowed for	Students from Set I & III
Eligibility Criteria for Schools	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Psychology [PSYC] must be running at the school or,</li><li>• Any two of the subjects Nutrition [NUTN] or Health &amp; Physical Education [HPED] or Human Development &amp; Resource Management [HDRM] both running at the school</li><li>• Duly qualified teacher in PSYC can teach this subject or would be taught jointly by teachers of NUTN or HDRM or HPED.</li></ul>
<i><b>In all cases, Consent from teacher needed stating that he/she would examine HS answer scripts of all those subjects which he/she would be teaching at the school</b></i>
